I think maybe communication from students to the instructor could be improved meaning sometimes I felt like I was being talked to in an accusatory way when I would ask about grades or assignments. Instead of blaming the student maybe have a response to questions about homework and tests that has the tone of cooperative problem solving and not accusation. Overall though I really enjoyed the course and would definitely recommend it to others!
 - Prof. Slaughter is a really great lecturer. She is probably one of the most organized instructors I have had at UCLA. She is also really passionate and excited about what she is teaching, which makes the class more enjoyable. She is also great at encouraging students who don't normally participate to participate.
 - Professor Slaughter engages with her classrooms in such a way that I have not had the privilege of having before. She is very welcoming towards people reserved and boisterous natures. lectures were very organized and easy to follow, especially in relation to the readings.

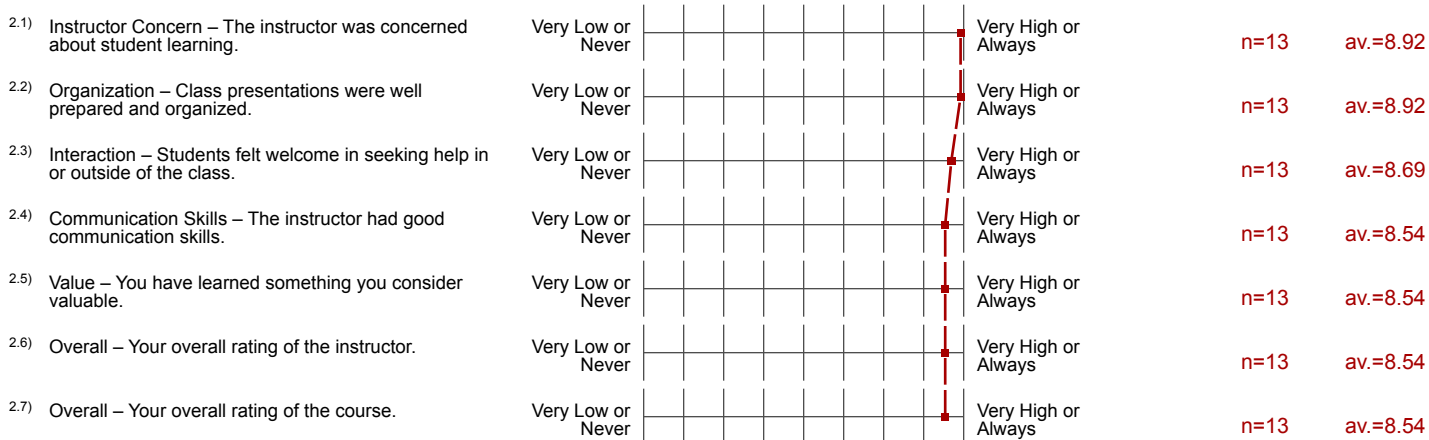
- She modifies the exams and the lectures based on what she thinks we find important which is great because I don't have to worry about being bombarded with information which was barely addressed in class.
